2. In the first box, write down what you know about the subject.
3. In the second box, based on what you know about the subject, write down what you think may be true.
4. In the third box, write down your prediction(s). What do you predict you will learn from reading this text?
5. Read the text- either confirm, reject, or refine your prediction(s) based on the new information you have gathered.
6. In the last box, summarize what you have learned by reading the text.
